Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about June 15, 2020, the City of Troy intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the Rebuild Illinois program. This program is funded by state funds as included in the 2019 Capital Bill. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: design engineering to provide upgrades and increased capacity to the City's wastewater treatment plant. The total amount of Rebuild Illinois funds to be requested is \$494,900. The City of Troy also proposes to expend \$515,100 in non-Rebuild Illinois funds on the project. These non-Rebuild Illinois funds will be derived from the following sources: Sewer Fund - \$515,100.

This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
