- b. <u>Irregular Proposals</u>-bid proposals will be considered irregular and may be rejected for any of the following reasons:

 - ii. If there are unauthorized additions, conditional or alternated bids, or irregularities of any kind which tend to make the proposal incomplete, indefinite, or ambiguous as to its meaning.
 - iii. If the bidder adds any provisions reserving the right to accept or reject an award, or to enter into a contract pursuant to an award.
 - iv. If the proposal does not contain the bid price amount written in numeric figures.

c. Delivery of bid proposals

e. Public opening of proposals

 - iii. Failure to supply complete information as requested by bid specifications.
