The City of Troy is seeking to qualify for funds from Madison County Community Development (MCCD) through a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to make Curb and Gutter and asphalt overlay improvements in your neighborhood.

In order to determine eligibility, the City, in conjunction with Madison County Community Development, is conducting an income survey. HUD requests that an income survey be carried out in areas of Madison County where the U.S. Census Bureau does not identify the specific project site as a low-moderate income area.
