

BOIL ORDER NOTICE

Attention Residents, The City of Troy Water Department has issued a boil order on (06/22/21) for **Low or no pressure due to a water main break.** Water will be off during the repair. Customers in the following locations are affected;

Chamberlain Dr. Between McClelland Dr. and Eisenhower Blvd.

When water service is returned, it is recommended to remove the aerators on your faucets and flush your faucets to remove any potential sediment.

Customers in the affected area should boil water for at least five minutes before using for drinking or cooking.

The Boil Order will remain in effect until further notice, until laboratory sampling confirms that water quality has been fully restored. You will be notified when the boil order has been lifted.
