A winter storm warning has been issued starting at Midnight tonight until Noon Thursday, beginning as rain, then sleet, then snow accumulations between 6-10 inches.

The City of Troy has approximately 53 mile of roads & 80 cul-de-sacs to maintain during a snow and ice event. Within the City of Troy, some roads and highways are plowed by the State of Illinois, Madison County, or township crews. The City has no jurisdiction over those streets. It takes our Public Works Department 3-4 hours to salt the entire City. Plowing begins with the designated snow routes during the storm. Once it stops snowing, it takes 10-12 hours to plow every street. **Please do not park on the street so the plow trucks can plow the entire street.** By ordinance, parking on designated snow routes is prohibited during snow events forecasting over two inches of snow. Stay home and give our Public Works Department time to clear the streets as quickly and safely as conditions allow.
