

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE III, SECTION 14-72,  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH DESIGNATED SNOW  
ROUTES AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR THE CITY OF TROY,  
ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 14, Article III, Section 14-72, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois, presently provides, "It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street in the city at any time within twelve (12) hours after a snowfall of three inches (3") or more has occurred";

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-208, authorizes the City of Troy, Illinois, to prohibit parking during snow removal operations upon posting of signs giving reasonable notice such regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to amend the Code of Ordinances to establish designated snow routes, parking restrictions and appropriate penalties.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Section 14-72 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth herein:

**SECTION 14-72. DESIGNATION OF SNOW ROUTES AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS DURING SNOW FALLS.**

- A. The following streets are hereby designated as snow routes:

SEE APPENDIX A attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

- B. There shall be no parking on either side of streets designated as snow routes twenty-four (24) hours after a two inch (2") snowfall has accumulated on such snow routes. The City of Troy shall post signs designating a street as a snow route and such signs shall be notice to the owners and operators of all motor vehicles that parking is prohibited.
- C. Parking may be resumed on individual streets as soon as final plowing, as announced by the City, has been completed on that street.

- D. Vehicles parked on snow routes in violation of this Section shall be towed and may be reclaimed upon payment of any towing and storage fee, if any.
- E. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to place and establish signs and such other devices in accordance with sound traffic engineering principals as are necessary to implement and execute this Section.

**Section 2.** Any violation of this Section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00).

**Section 3.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
