For Improvement of the intersection of IL 162 and Old Troy Road

The City of Troy will hold a Public Information Meeting at the Troy City Hall, March 19, 2025 from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. The Meeting will present the proposed replacement of the intersections of IL 162 and Old Troy Road with a new roundabout.

All persons interested in the project are invited to attend. The meeting will be informal with no formal presentation. Displays of proposed improvements and land acquisition, in plan view, will be available for viewing. The project need, design alternatives, the closure and right-of-way acquisition will be discussed. This is a federally-funded project and the public information meeting is being held in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements and the Illinois Department of Transportation's public involvement policy.

The existing parking lot for accessing the MCT Goshen Trail north and east of IL 162 and Old Troy Road will remain open throughout construction and there will be no closure of the Goshen Trail or the bridge carrying it over IL 162. The trail is subject to protection under Section 4(f) of the USDOT Act of 1966.
