

SNOW ROUTE REMINDER

During snow and ice events residents should keep all vehicles parked off the street. Large obstacles i.e....trash cans, basketball goals, snow forts should be kept off the streets during and after snow events until the snow plowing is completed. Also removing snow from around fire hydrants in your yards would help the fire department in case of emergency.

Snow routes take into consideration high traffic volume, emergency service, transit routes, and critical locations. Plowing of the snow routes will start at about two to three inches snow and continue during the snow event. The snow routes will have the primary effort during the snow/ice event. The secondary streets will be processed after the event is over with priority to the snow routes in case of blowing snow.

72.27 PARKING RESTRICTIONS DURING SNOWFALLS; SNOW ROUTES.

(A) *Generally.* It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street in the city at any time within 12 hours after a snowfall of three inches or more has occurred.

(1986 Code, § 14-72)

(B) *Snow routes.*

(1) There shall be no parking on either side of streets designated as snow routes 24 hours after a two-inch snowfall has accumulated on the snow routes. The city shall post signs designating a street as a snow route and these signs shall be notice to the owners and operators of all motor vehicles that parking is prohibited.

(2) Parking may be resumed on individual streets as soon as final plowing, as announced by the city, has been completed on that street.

(3) Vehicles parked on snow routes in violation of this division (B) shall be towed and may be reclaimed upon payment of any towing and storage fee, if any.

(4) The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to place and establish signs and other devices in accordance with sound traffic engineering principles as are necessary to implement and execute this section.
